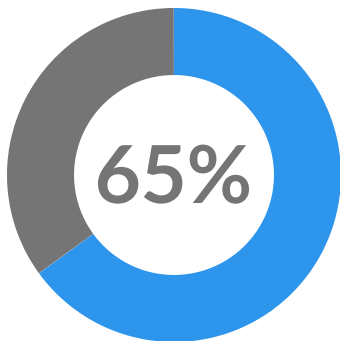

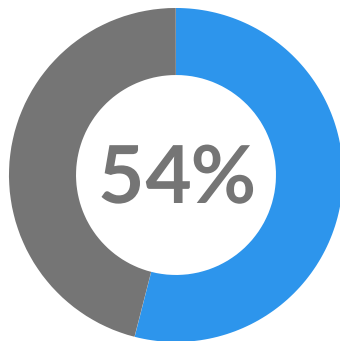

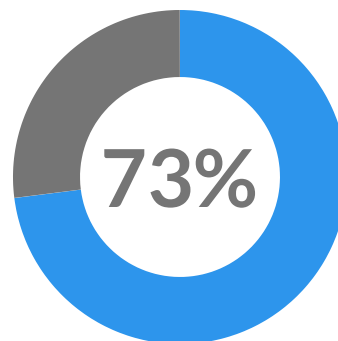
### FAMILY DOCTOR

Majority (65%) of respondents go to their family doctor when they are looking for health related information



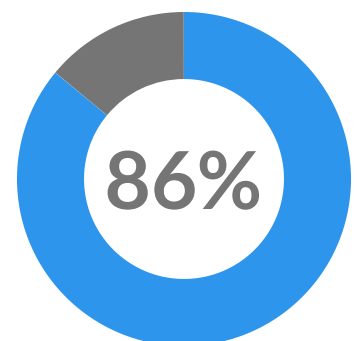
### SATISFACTION
